Last year I participated in the last Spirituality Fair being hosted with a few friends from Paraparaumu. The organisers' have decided it is no longer viable for them. We had so many conversations at these fairs with spiritually minded people I will look for other opportunities at similar fairs.

I am scheduled for some surgery towards the end of this month and will look at some part-time work opportunities after several weeks' recovery. I have not been able to work for a while and look forward to that as I have many conversations with a wide group of people when I do.
