out every day and did open air outreaches with the sketch board stories.

Kevin is quite artistic and really enjoyed doing chalk drawings.

While some days are quite tough other days are very fruitful which makes you forget the tough days. Such as the opportunity to teach students about Cain and Abel, Jeremiah 31:31, The Samaritan Woman at the well, Jesus healing the crippled man at the pool of Bethesda, Jesus healing a woman and Jairus daughter and others.
